5. Jack: Today we went to a little nice town nearby.

Jack reported they had gone to a little nice town near their hotel.

6. Officer: Are you travelling with your parents?

The officer wanted to know whether we were travelling with our parents. The officer wanted to know whether they were travelling with their parents.

7. Dad: Don't lie to me!

Dad told me not to lie.

Dad told him / her / them not to lie.

8. Mum: Did you give Aunt Lizy our new phone number?

Mum asked <u>me</u> whether <u>I</u> had given Aunt Lizy <u>our</u> new phone number. Mum asked her whether she had given Aunt Lizy their new phone number.
